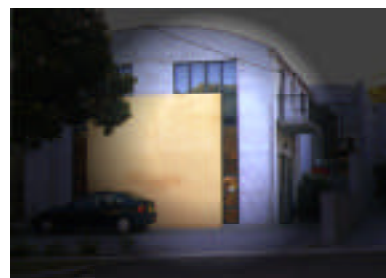

Luciano Dal Bo - Baritone

Born in Treviso, near Venice Italy Luciano Dal Bo studied opera music, with Master Alemanno the grand tenor Mario Del Monaco's collaborator and assistant.

He also undertook music theory studies with masters Miglioranza Silvano and Loja Alessand a soloist for S.Agnese choir in Treviso and collaborates with opera choir "Pagensis" in Paese, "Scola Cantorum S. Daniele di Povegliano".

He performed in the 2nd and 3rd prestigious Mario Del Monaco's International Competition for singers and in numerous successful concerts, in Italy and abroad. He has performed sacral Churches such as S.Stefano in Vienna and S.Pietro in Rome with noted organists Sergio Amedeo Aroma, Giovanni Feltrin, Corrado Girardi, Antonio Disco and the Filarmonia Veneta O He took part in the first edition of the "Venice Carnivale" played in the S. Marco Square ar Signori Square in Treviso for a talented singers concert. At present his performance focus is century composers for sacral and operatic music.
